

## **BIOGRAPHIE**

Mark Sturkenboom (Driebergen, 1983)

Sturkenboom was formerly a welder before graduating with honors in 2012 at Artez, Institute for the Arts in Arnhem. Sturkenboom is trained as a designer, but now acts as an independent artist.

Design is a word that can mean a great deal of different things depending on the time, place and context that one chooses to view it in. The Oxford English Dictionary defines design as: "Purpose, planning, or intention that exists or is thought to exist behind an action, fact, or material object" Perhaps that's his only tie with design; Sturkenboom creates purposeful, intentional objects. In doing so, he works together with devoted craftsmen and artisans around the world. His work is part of public and private collections and exhibitions worldwide.

Sturkenboom delivers absolute statements through fierce intention, careful planning, and a purposeful energy that proliferates in his will to express. Throughout all of this he manages to balance a visual cadence between the absurd and a sharp sense of humor. He welcomes the viewer to casually slip into his conceptual narrative.

Memory is prevalent in his line of work, throughout his entire oeuvre is the ability to preserve a moment in a state of crystal clarity. Memory is messy, it is flavored by myriad personal influences. Memory changes, morphing with age and experience, fading into personal fictions, diluting into deep well of life's experience. Sturkenboom works against the entropic process, realizing his ideas with clean lines, a sensitive palette, careful mechanisms that resist the temptation of clutter and confusion. He realizes single memories with exacting intention.

Lets take one example: We, as a culture fear death, and we do our best not to think of it. Sturkenboom's work 21 Grams drives us to consider it. But this consideration is faceted, it contains within it a breadth of sentiments. More contemplative than it is macabre, more playful than it is perverse. 21 Grams, like a prism, refracts an emotional muddle into distinct perspectives of personal perspective.

Lets take another example: We, as a culture, are enamored by objects - perfect forms created in organized environments. Physical human beauty is always cruel because it will absolutely disappear. With his Crystallized Overgrown mirrors he illustrates this fading beauty which is subjected to time.

Manufacture is comfortable because it always yields the same result. These are the cruxes of the work of Sturkenboom, he resists manufacture, he embraces material. He weaves together histories, he composites the living memory with the permanence of genuine mediums. Offering the everlasting object, balanced with the fragility of human experience.






These mouth blown glass lights are overgrown with natural crystal for which Sturkenboom developed a liquid that allows objects to grow crystals in a short period of time.

The Japanese Akoya pearl grows in several years to perfection, this is part pre-manipulated but the outcome is not always a guaranteed success.

Not only does it takes patience but also the understanding of not being a 100 % in control.

Like Mikimoto grows their pearl with the influence of time (two years) this crystal piece is also one of time. This timepiece is kept in a solution which allows to grow and crystalize the pearl further, beyond Japanese standards.


Crystals evolve out of the mechanism, out of the gold parts and out of the pearls.

Creating a new natural grown (im)perfection.

The leather cabinet contains an crystalized device holding an crystalized engagement ring, twirling around, waiting to be given away. The crystal piece ring is placed under a glass dome as a clockwork timeframe.


And there is a collier that bares the key that opens the cabinet.

Sweet Anticipation is Mark Sturkenbooms pièce de résistance. A 50.000 euro one-of-a kind mousetrap that is designed to change the arrival of the unwanted guest into an arrival of the long awaited.

In 2012, the idea rose about changing our perspective about the modern household, that of over-regulated domains, to be more precise. Because there is a strict order as to who we allow to enter and stay and who we exclude from this privilege. This includes humans as well as animals. The precursor to Sweet Anticipation was born.

Now, seven years after this prototype, we present it's successor. Sweet Anticipation is a luxury and unique mousetrap that includes mouth blown and glass engraved components, a Japanese handknotted silk rope, a raw and uncut diamond and a 18ct gold entrance for it's guest.

With this object that waits to be lived in, one can domesticate a wild intruder and force him or her to became one's companion. Of course, it provides the mouse with a safe place to stay, water and food at hand, but more important it changes our attitudes. The owner of this trap will inevitably wake up one morning with the strong wish that his or her mouse trap will no longer be empty.

Sweet Anticipation is the result.







Love Potion is a series of mouth blown and handcrafted glass bottles that hold an elixir based on pheromones and (animal) instinct.

What would be the one thing you would save or preserve if a flood is coming? Inspired by Noah's Ark and Julian Barnes' A History of the World in 10 Chapters;

This 21th century Ark is a vessel that waits for this flood to come, and when it does then it will take off and set sail into the world.

The Ark includes a barometer that can predict when a storm is coming. In the leather box, inside the glass dome, one can place a relic, secret or manifesto then seal it and pass—it on for future generations. It's not about the esthetic or materialistic value one wants to display.

The Ark makes us think about that what is of importance to us, and perhaps of what's just static.

But more important, the Ark displays the necessity to ask that question.

Ark (Volume 2): Paradigm Shift is the second unique edition of Sturkenboom's Ark series. With the first Ark, Sturkenboom investigated the conceptual underpinnings of what is most important to the individual and what one wants preserve when the world faces the great flood.

Ark (Volume 2) has an existential inclination; questioning the significance of human life and the role we play in this universe, building upon the notion that we are just a small spectacle in an ever-expanding galaxy.

The Ark is a vessel to explore an ongoing dialogue between utopia and dystopia and a means to explore a fictional scenario about time and space, reflecting on current and potential futures such as afterlife and time travel.
